# COMMUNICATION ON REGISTRY OPERATIONS OF GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION REDUCTION PROJECTS

#### **Objective**

**ARTICLE 1** – (1) The objective of this Communication is to regulate the principles and procedures concerning the registry of projects carried out to reduce and limit greenhouse gas emissions and increase sinks within the context of combating climate change.

#### Scope

**ARTICLE 2** – (1) This Communication covers the principles and procedures on the methodology to be followed in registering the projects that have been or will be carried out within the territories of the Republic of Turkey in the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Project Register and on informing the public.

#### **Legal Basis**

**ARTICLE 3** – (1) This Communication has been prepared in accordance with the relevant provisions of the following legal texts:

- a) Environmental Law no. 2872 dated 9/8/1983,
- b) Law No. 4856 on the Organization and Duties of the Ministry of Environment and Forests, dated 1/5/2003,
- c) The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), ratified by Law No. 4990 dated 16/10/2003,
- ç) The Kyoto Protocol to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change, ratified by Law No.5836 dated 5/2/2009,
- d) The Vienna Convention for the Protection of the Ozone Layer, ratified by Law no.3655 dated 20/6/1990,
- e) The Montreal Protocol on Substances That Deplete the Ozone Layer, ratified by Law no. 3656 dated 20/6/1990,
- f) The Regulation on Duties, Working Principles and Procedures of the Central Organization of the Ministry of Environment and Forestry, no. 25348 and dated 16/1/2004.

# **Definitions**

**ARTICLE 4** – (1) The terms used in this Communication refer to the following meanings:

- a) Designated Operational Entity: An independent third party entity or organization accredited by the relevant bodies of the Protocol and authorized to validate and verify projects,
- b) Ministry: The Ministry of Environment and Forestry,
- c) Verification: The procedure of verifying the greenhouse gas reductions declared by a project validated by a designated operational entity, through periodical review, measurement, monitoring and auditing based on accepted verification criteria,
- ç) Verification report: The report issued by the Designated Operational Entity following verification,
- d) Emission: Greenhouse gas emissions,
- e) Emission reduction: Greenhouse gas emission reduction, limitation or removal in metric ton of carbon dioxide equivalent achieved as a result of the project,
- f) Emission Reduction Purchase Agreement: Emission reduction purchase agreement regarding purchase of emission reduction certificates generated by the project,
- g) Directorate General: Directorate General for Environmental Management,
- g) Metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent: Unit in metric tons for describing the global warming potential of greenhouse gases using carbon dioxide as a reference,
- h) Carbon market: The market where greenhouse emission reduction certificates are sold and purchased,
- 1) Validation: The validation procedure by the designated operational entity as a result of assessment of greenhouse gas reductions declared in a project based on accepted validation criteria,
- i) Validation Report: The document issued by the designated operational entity following validation,
- j) Project: Greenhouse emission reduction project,
- k) Project developer: The legal entity developing greenhouse gas reduction project or organization/institution authorised for developing project,
- l) Project design document: Document containing information specific to the project developed within the framework of any internationally recognized carbon market standard,
- m) Protocol: The Kyoto Protocol,
- n) Greenhouse gases: Gases causing global warming, which are being controlled by the Kyoto Protocol and the Montreal Protocol,

- o) Greenhouse gas emission reduction project: A project developed or being developed to obtain verified emission reduction certificates, or that has obtained verified emission reduction certificates, for the purpose of reduction of one or more greenhouse gases,
- ö) Certificate: Emission reduction certificate obtained through certification of greenhouse gas reductions verified by the designated operational entity,
- p) Registry: Greenhouse Gas Reduction Project Registry established by the Ministry,
- r) Convention: The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

#### **Project owner record**

**ARTICLE 5** - (1) The owners, of which projects are to be registered in the Registry that is established through this Communication must have themselves recorded at the Ministry.

(2) Project owners applying for the first time to have their projects registered should submit the forms and documents listed in Annex-1 of this Communication to the Ministry. Project owners submitting the documents fully and accurately to the Ministry shall be registered upon approval of the Ministry.

#### **Project registry**

**ARTICLE 6** – (1) Project owners recorded at the Ministry shall apply to the Ministry to have their projects registered. Projects started or finalized after 24/5/2004, projects ongoing at the date of coming into effect of this Communication and projects that will start at a future date shall be eligible for registry.

- (2) In order to register the project, the project owner shall submit the following documents to the Ministry:
- a) For projects at the validation stage:
  - 1) Project Identification Form (Annex-2).
- b) For validated projects:
  - 1) Project Identification Form (Annex-2),
  - 2) Sustainable Development Criteria (Annex-3),
  - 3) Validated project design document,
- 4) If in another language, Turkish summary of the validated project design document approved by the project developer,
  - 5) The validation report,
- 6) If in another language, a Turkish summary prepared by the Designated Operational Entity or notary public-approved Turkish translation of the validation reports.
- c) For verified projects:
  - 1) Project Identification Form (Annex-2),
  - 2) Sustainable Development Criteria (Annex-3),
  - 3) Validated project design document,
- 4) If in another language, a Turkish summary of the validated project design document approved by the Project owner,
  - 5) Validation report,
  - 6) Verification report,
- 7) If in another language, Turkish summaries prepared by the Designated Operational Entity or notary public-approved Turkish translations of the validation and verification reports.
- (3) Projects with complete project application documents and approved by the Ministry shall be registered and registry number shall be assigned to the projects. For applications not found suitable, an additional time period of fifteen workdays shall be granted. These projects shall be registered in case all conditions specified by the Ministry are fully met within this timeframe.
- (4) Applications of validated projects shall be assessed within forty workdays at latest, and a "Registry Approval Document", as given in Annex-4, shall be issued in case the application is found suitable within the framework of the national sustainable development criteria included in Annex-3 of this Communication.
- (5) Information and documents related to projects granted with a Registry Approval Letter shall be shared with the public via the website of the Directorate General.

## **Post-Registry Procedures**

**ARTICLE 7** – (1) Reports related to the validation or verification statuses of projects shall be sent to the Ministry within twenty workdays after they are obtained, together with their Turkish summaries approved by the Project owner if in another language.

- (2) In case registered project certificates lose their validity, the situation shall be notified to the Ministry together with the relevant verification report.
- (3) The Project phases shall be shared with the public via the website of the Directorate General.

# Notification and confidentiality of information and documents

- **ARTICLE 8** (1) Unless otherwise stated in the relevant articles of this Communication, information and documents sent to the Ministry cannot be shared with third parties without the project owner's consent. When deems necessary, the Ministry may require submittal of an additional document or information to this end.
- (2) Project developers shall comply with the obligation to notify the Ministry within twenty workdays of any changes in the information and documents submitted to the Ministry or any changes that may terminate a project-related contract/agreement or that can affect the status of the project in the Register. Registries and projects of project owners failing to fulfil this obligation or declaring inaccurate information or documents shall be removed from the Register, and any "Registry Approval Letter" that may have been issued shall be cancelled. Any such situation shall be made public through the website of the Directorate General.

#### **Enforcement**

**ARTICLE 9** – (1) The provisions of this Communication shall come into effect on the date of their publication.

#### Execution

**ARTICLE 10** – (1) The provisions of this Communication shall be executed by the Minister of Environment and Forestry.
